Danko Kocis was born in 1982 in Djakovo, where he started his journey into astronomy, astronautics and technical culture. He graduated in Computer sciences and Business informatics in 2019, At Victoria International University. He is currently working at the Multinorm Ltd as an IT/ERP manager from 2015.

Her grew up in a family passionate about radio amateurism and electrical engineering, igniting in him a lifelong love for technology. His interest in space led him to assume leadership of the "Orion" Astronomical Society in his hometown of Djakovo. As an excellent promoter of not only space related topics but also technical culture in general, Kocis was named Croatia's national coordinator for the United Nations' World Space Week. Over the past five years, he has organized more than 500 lectures and workshops involving thousands of young people annually and have positioned Croatia among the top 5 countries worldwide in youth participation in space-related activities. For his work Kocis received National prize for technical culture in 2022, and servers as member of Board of Directors of Croatian National Astronomical Society.

Internationally acclaimed for his dedication to youth education in space related topics, he was appointed as Secretary General of the Adriatic Aerospace Association in 2021, where he spearheads national space educational projects like current Cansat Rocketry project.
